Technical Inspection will be open on Thursday July 4th from 7:00 – 8:30pm for pre-entered riders only. Technical Inspection will open at 6:30am Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. All pre-entries will be paperless. Contingency forms must be turned in at Technical Inspection.

Technical Inspection is located under the covered paddock area at the base of the control tower.

Event credential and pre-entry or at-track entry receipt is required to enter Technical Inspection.

A CMRA Tech Verification Form must be completed with VIN# and turned in annually for all machines
