GATE HOURS AND ADMISSION FEES

ALL CMRA COMPETITORS WHO ARE NOT MSR MEMBERS OR GUESTS OF MEMBERS MUST WAIT AT THE MAIN ENTRANCE UNTIL 6:00PM! The main entrance will be staffed from 6:00am to 12:00am Saturday 5/17. The main entrance will be staffed starting at 6:00am on Sunday 5/18. All competitors need to vacate the paddock by 10:00pm on Sunday 5/18. Anyone arriving after hours must return to the main entrance at 6:00am to complete the waiver process, pay gate fees, and pick up event credentials.

Gate Fees for adults are as follows: Friday-Sunday \$20, Saturday-Sunday, \$20, Sunday only \$15. Kids 12 and under are free.

LICENSING & REGISTRATION

A Riders Briefing will be held each morning at 7:10am.

All riders participating in each days practice and or races are required to attend.

TECHNICAL INSPECTION

Technical Inspection will be open on Friday May 16th from 7:00 – 8:30pm for pre-entered riders only. Technical Inspection will open at 6:30am Saturday and Sunday. All pre-entries will be paperless. Contingency forms must be turned in at Technical Inspection.

Technical Inspection is located under the covered paddock area at the base of the control tower.

Event credential and pre-entry or at-track entry receipt is required to enter Technical Inspection.

A CMRA Tech Verification Form must be completed with VIN# and turned in annually for all machines
